Quarterly Report Summary

Fiscal Year 2020: Quarter 3

The purpose of this quarterly report is to provide insight into the potential, ongoing, and awarded actions under the ProTech Program. ProTech is a suite of multiple award indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity contracts, and other contracting vehicles covering five domains: Satellite, Fisheries, Oceans, Weather, and Enterprise Operations. The ceiling dollar amount for all orders under all ProTech Domains is \$3,000,000,000.00.

For Q3 FY2020 there were 20 Task Orders awarded across the 4 ProTech Domains. The Total Award Value of those 20 Task Orders is \$97,578,073 with a Total Obligated Amount of \$15,962,890.

The current Awarded Amount for the ProTech Task Orders across all Domains is \$578,495,068. The remaining Program Ceiling Amount is \$2,421,504,932.

Chart 1: Awards (% by \$)




Chart 2 is an overview of the set-aside determination for task orders currently under solicitation or evaluation.

Chart 2: Task Order Set-Aside Determination (% by \$)




Chart 3 is an overview of the set-aside determinations for all task order solicitations to date.




Chart 4 contains the status of the remaining ceiling available for the ProTech Program.




Chart 5 provides an overview of the Satellite Domain task order awards accomplished to date by socio-economic status.




Chart 6 provides an overview of the Fisheries Domain task order awards accomplished to date by socio-economic status.




Chart 7 provides an overview of the Oceans Domain task order awards accomplished to date by socio-economic status.


